

## CT Pansinusitis



### HISTORY

Chronic sinusitis, chronic otitis media, allergic rhinitis.

### TECHNIQUE

Helical acquisition of the paranasal sinuses was performed without contrast according to standard protocol. Coronal and sagittal reconstruction images were also generated.

### FINDINGS

The frontal sinus is normally developed and almost completely opacified. The right and left middle meatus is also opacified completely. There is also almost complete opacification of the ethmoids and right and left maxillary sinus. The sphenoid sinus is also partially opacified. The nasal turbinates demonstrate no obvious abnormality. No bony erosions are noted. The nasal septum demonstrates no significant abnormality. The right and left ostiomeatal unit are patent. There is also opacification of the right-sided mastoids. The left-sided mastoids are clear.
